## GENERATION 8 CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2019

*"Our family has an affinity to Cabernet Sauvignon," explains CEO, Petrus Bosman. "My grandfather believed that by blending a small portion of Cabernet into a red wine, it would take that wine to a whole new level."*

Our farm in the Bovlei is well suited to the cultivation of Cabernet Sauvignon. Early summers give the grapes time to ripen, while well-drained soils and a myriad of slopes form the basis of interesting terroir variations which enhance the complexity of the wine.



<b>ORIGIN</b>	Wellington, South Africa.
<b>VINTAGE REPORT</b>	We expected another early harvest as in 2016, but that didn't happen. We waited and waited, grapes came in slowly and then the pace picked up furiously and it was all over within days: a great crop with good pH's. Our 10th vintage!
<b>VINEYARDS</b>	Different sites have produced a variation of grapes from a young, fruit-driven style to older vineyards that express elegance.
<b>WINEMAKING</b>	The fruit from the various vineyards are hand harvested; received in the cellar; destemmed, pressed and fermented in stainless steel tanks. Matured for 6 months with oak to create a complex wine with a solid structure and supple tannins.
<b>VARIETAL</b>	100% Cabernet Sauvignon.
<b>ANALYSIS</b>	Alc 12.8% Vol R/Sugar 2.4 g/l TA 5.3g/l pH 3.6
<b>COLOUR</b>	Deep crimson with a puce edge.
<b>NOSE</b>	Reflect on what matters: Beautiful blackberry and plum aromas are rounded out by a long, fruit-packed finish.
<b>PALATE</b>	A velvety mouth-feel with a fruity, lingering finish.
<b>FOOD</b>	Pair this with hearty beef casseroles and roasted meats. It will provide an interesting talking point in front of a hearty winter's fire.
<b>AGEING POTENTIAL</b>	To be enjoyed 2-5 years from the year of vintage.
